



Warehouse, logistics hub may come up close to Noida airport

Greater Noida: Tappal Bajna, some 7km from the upcoming Jewar international airport, could become one of the region's largest logistics and warehousing hubs, if Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) moves ahead with its proposal for the same under its Master Plan Phase-II.

A preliminary report submitted by consultant Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu India engaged in preparing the feasibility study and the detailed project report has recommended rail connectivity of the hub — proposed across 465 hectares — with the Delhi-Palwal route. Once ready, it will be a major point of industrial goods offload, officials said. "We have proposed the logistics and warehousing hub in Tappal Bajna Urban Centre under the Master Plan Phase-II. We have appointed Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu India for preparing the feasibility study-cum-DPR of the proposed logistics and warehousing hub in the area," said Monika Rani, additional CEO of YEIDA.

While the inception report has been submitted by the consultant, it has also recommended that the logistics and warehousing hub be well connected via road and rail. The report suggests connecting this hub with the Delhi-Palwal rail road, with 16km of track laid for the purpose.

NEW DELHI: The government has approved the master plan for the upcoming Noida International Airport (NIA) which will begin operations in about three years by handling 1.2 crore passengers annually with one terminal and a runway.

During its 40-year concession period, it will reach a peak capacity of 7 crore passengers in a four-phase expansion through two runways and as many terminals.

The master plan, prepared by aviation consultants Landrum & Brown and Zurich Airport International, has been cleared by DGCA, AAI, BCAS and environmental authorities.

Construction of UP's first film city near Noida likely to start in January 2022

NOIDA: The construction of Noida Film City, a pet project of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, is likely to start in January 2022, state government officials said Monday.

The film city, to be developed on a public-private partnership model at an estimated cost of Rs 6,000 crore, is proposed to come up in Sector 21 of the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) in Gautam Buddh Nagar district, the officials said.

"The preparations for the construction of the film city at YEIDA city are in full swing with the approval of the detailed project report (DPR) that was submitted to the state government recently by consultant company CBRE South Asia Private Limited," YEIDA CEO Arun Vir Singh said.

Adityanath had on September 18 directed YEIDA to submit its proposal for establishing a film city to the state government.

"There are massive opportunities associated with the film industry, not to mention the investment potential. It is expected to lead to five times growth in real estate values – the Rs 5,000 crore investment is expected to generate benefits worth Rs 25,000 crore," Singh told Moneycontrol, a day after YEIDA announced that Fortune 500 company CBRE would prepare the blueprint for the film city.

"The biggest benefit of establishing a film city is that it generates huge employment. All big projects such as the Jewar airport project and now the film city project are expected to have a multiplier effect," he said.

Housing would be required for everybody working in the film city, he added.

NOIDA: The Uttar Pradesh government has through a letter asked the Noida Metro Rail Corporation (NMRC) to revise the detailed plan report (DPR) that was drawn by the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) for a metro line from Greater Noida's Knowledge Park to Jewar International Airport.

DMRC had handed over the DPR of Rs 5,708-crore metro project to the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA). After approval, the DPR was sent to the state government.
