RAJAJI NATIONAL PARK

Rajaji National Park is situated in the state of Uttarakhand, now known as Uttarakhand. The picturesque beauty and rich biodiversity of the park serve as its major attractions for both nature lovers as well as wildlife enthusiasts. In the year 1983, Rajaji Wildlife Sanctuary of Uttaranchal was merged with Motichur and Chilla wildlife sanctuaries and made into Rajaji National Park. The park has been named after Late Sri C. Rajgopalachari (also known as Rajaji), a famous freedom fighter and first governor general of India. Rajaji National Park of India spreads over an area of 820.42 sq km and is open to visitors only from Mid-November to Mid-June.

Park Location

Rajaji National Park is situated along the hills and foothills of Shiwalik ranges in the Himalayan foothills and represent the Shiwalik eco-system. Combining three sanctuaries, namely Chilla, Motichur and Rajaji - Rajaji National Park is spread over the Pauri Garwal, Dehradun and Saharanpur districts of Uttarakhand. The Motichur and Rajaji sanctuaries are contiguous, and are separated from the Chilla Sanctuary to the south-east by the Ganges River and the Chilla River.



Maa Shakumbhari University



Maa Shakumbhari University is a State University, situated at the village Punwarka of district Saharanpur in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. It was established by Uttar Pradesh State Universities Act, 2019. The university was inaugurated on December 2, 2021 by Honorable Home Minister Sri Amit Shah and Honorable Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh Sri Yogi Adityanathji in gracious presence of the Honorable Deputy Chief Minister Sri Dinesh Sharma and honorable Union Education Minister Sri Dharmendra Pradhan. The foundation stone of the proposed majestic building of the University was also laid down. The University campus and residential campus is being built on 50 acres of land. At present the University is housing in the Government College, Punwarka.

The University is going to be advantageous to all the affiliated colleges which includes 11 aided Colleges, 8 Government Colleges and 193 Self-Financed Colleges. The territorial jurisdiction of the University is Saharanpur Mandal comprising of three districts viz., Saharanpur, Muzaffarnagar and Shamli. An estimated 1.50 lakh students will be benefitted by this university. Previously, these colleges were affiliated to Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut. It was very tedious and bothersome for the staff as well as for students to go all the way to Meerut to get their problems resolved.

Delhi-Dehradun Expressway

The Delhi-Dehradun Expressway project includes a 12-kilometer elevated wildlife corridor near Rajaji National Park, designed to ensure safe passage for animals. This corridor is Asia's longest and is part of a larger effort to protect wildlife while improving road infrastructure. The expressway also features six animal underpasses and two elephant underpasses to further mitigate human-wildlife conflicts.

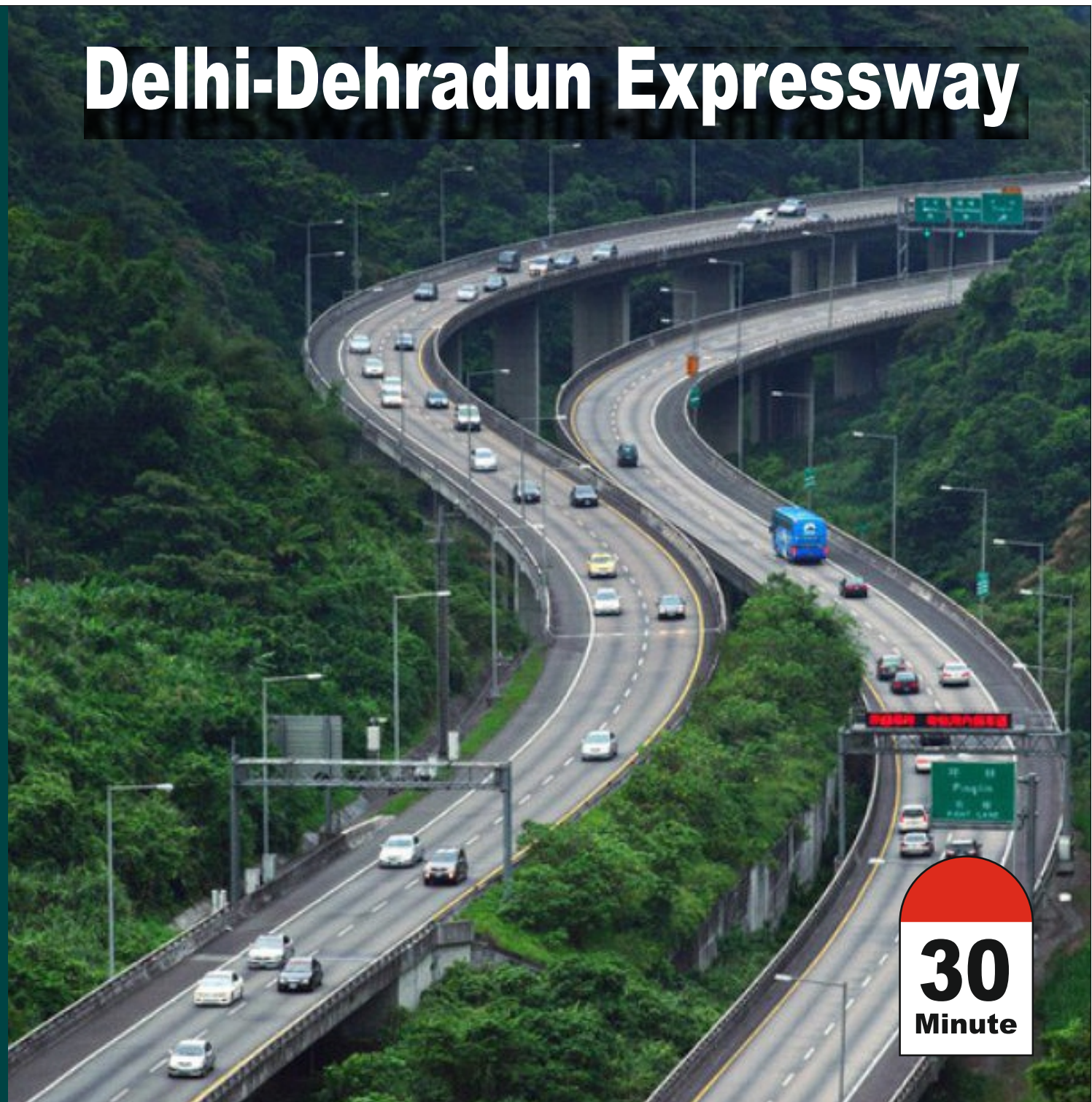
Elaboration:

Purpose:

The wildlife corridor aims to minimize the impact of the expressway on the natural habitat of Rajaji National Park and nearby wildlife.

Design:

The 12-kilometer elevated section, along with underpasses, allows animals to safely cross the road without disrupting their movement or behavior.



SARSAWA AIRPORT



Sarsawa airport, also known as Saharanpur Airport, is an upcoming domestic airport (civil enclave at the Indian Air Force's Sarsawa Air Force Station) in Saharanpur district in the state of Uttar Pradesh, India. The civil terminal of the airport will be built at 20 km away from Saharanpur and 2.5 km away from Sarsawa.

Proposed Destinations
Under the regional connectivity scheme UDAN, it is proposed to have direct flights to Lucknow, Prayagraj, Gorakhpur, Varanasi, Kanpur, Kushinagar, and Ayodhya.

Dehradun-Mussoorie Ropeway



The Dehradun-Mussoorie ropeway, also known as the Mussoorie Sky Car, is a planned 5.2-kilometer mono-cable detachable gondola system that will connect Dehradun to Mussoorie. This project, expected to start operations in September 2026, promises to drastically reduce travel time between the two cities. The ropeway will ascend 1,000 meters and cover the distance in just 20 minutes, compared to the usual 2-hour road journey.

Key Features:

Length: 5.2 kilometers.

Type: Mono-cable detachable gondola system.

Capacity: 1,300 passengers per hour in each direction. Travel Time: Reduced from 2 hours (by road) to 20 minutes.

Safety: Designed and built to European safety standards. Developer: Mussoorie Sky Car Private Limited.

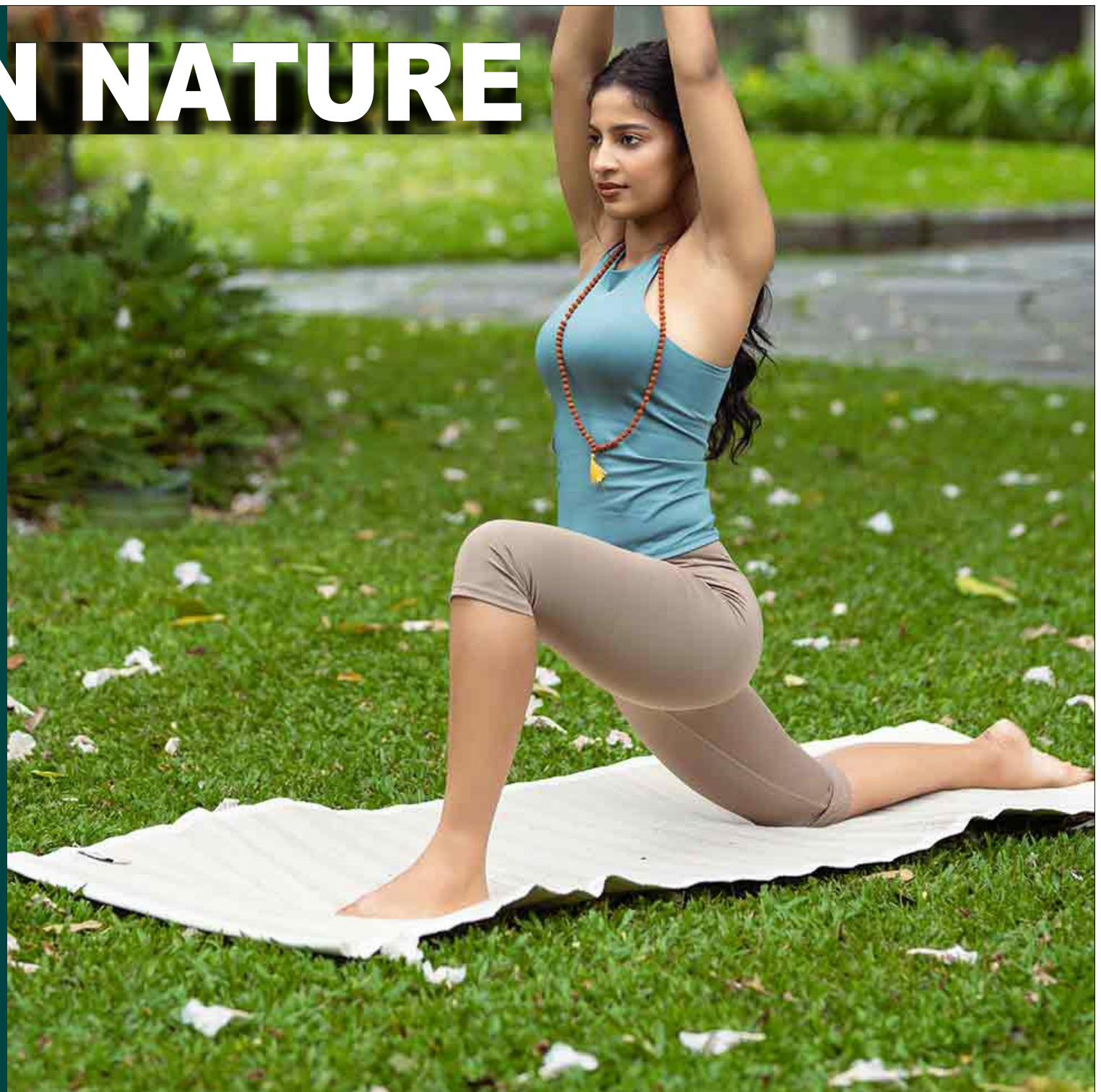
Aroma Spa Therapy

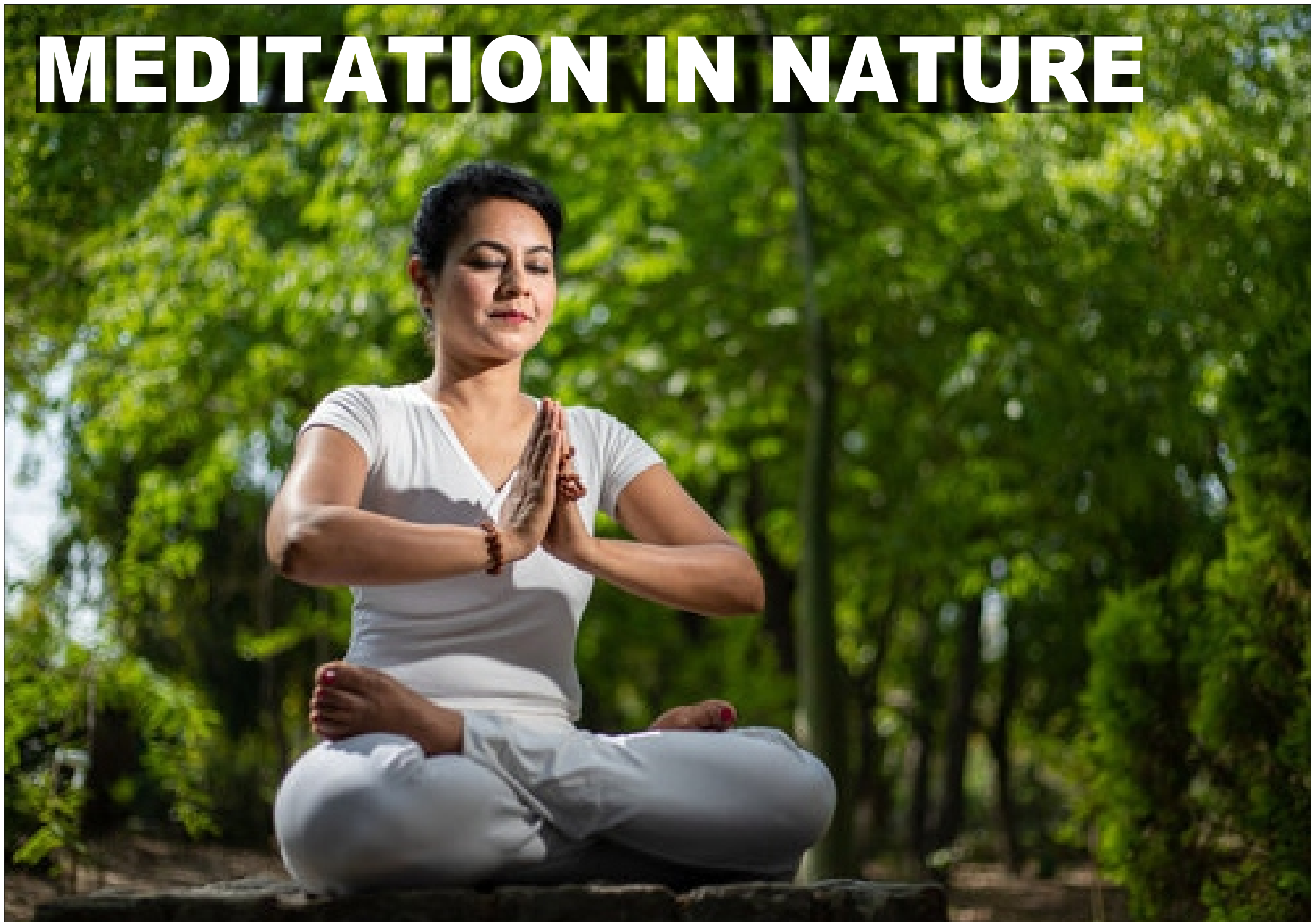

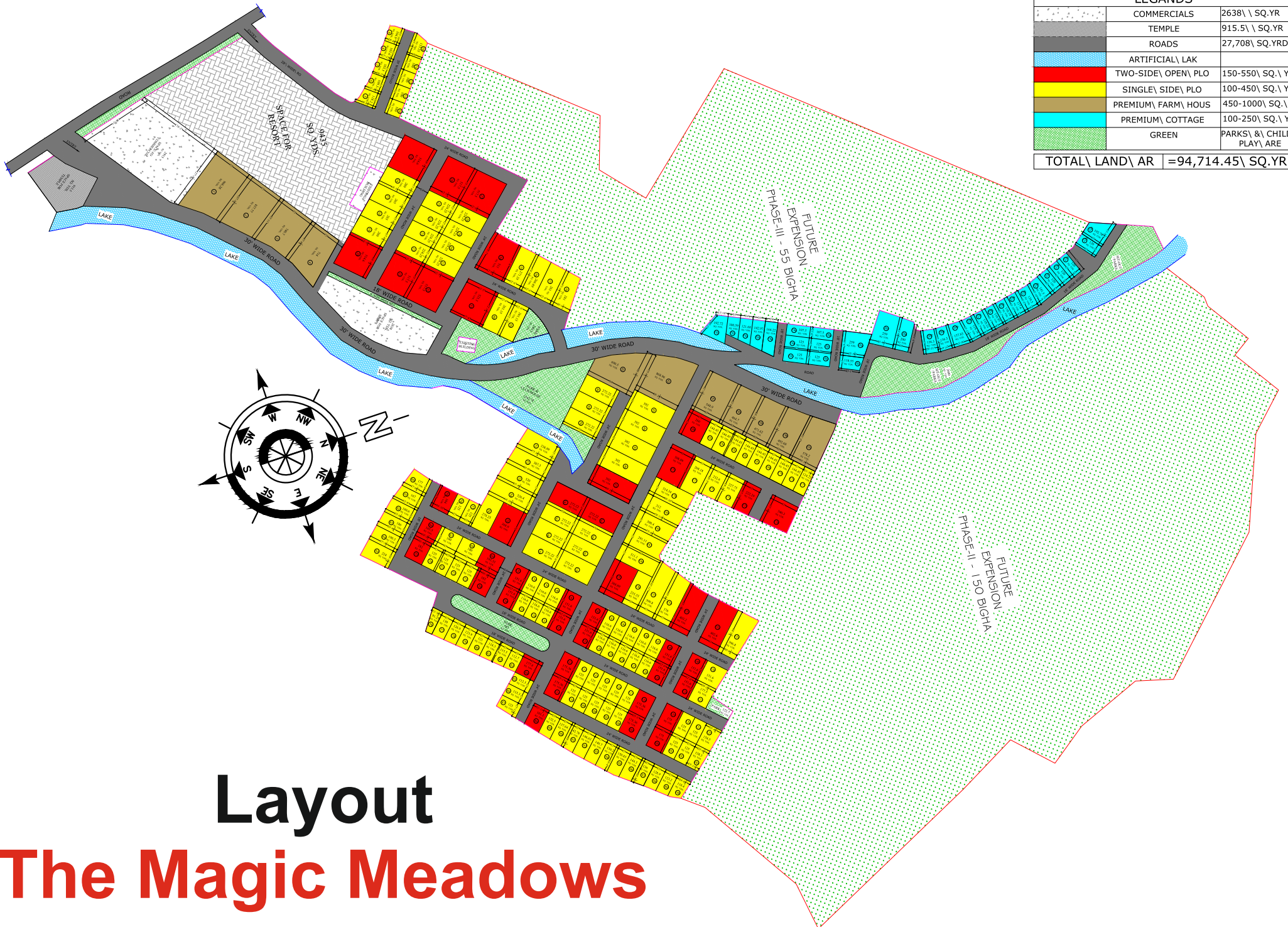

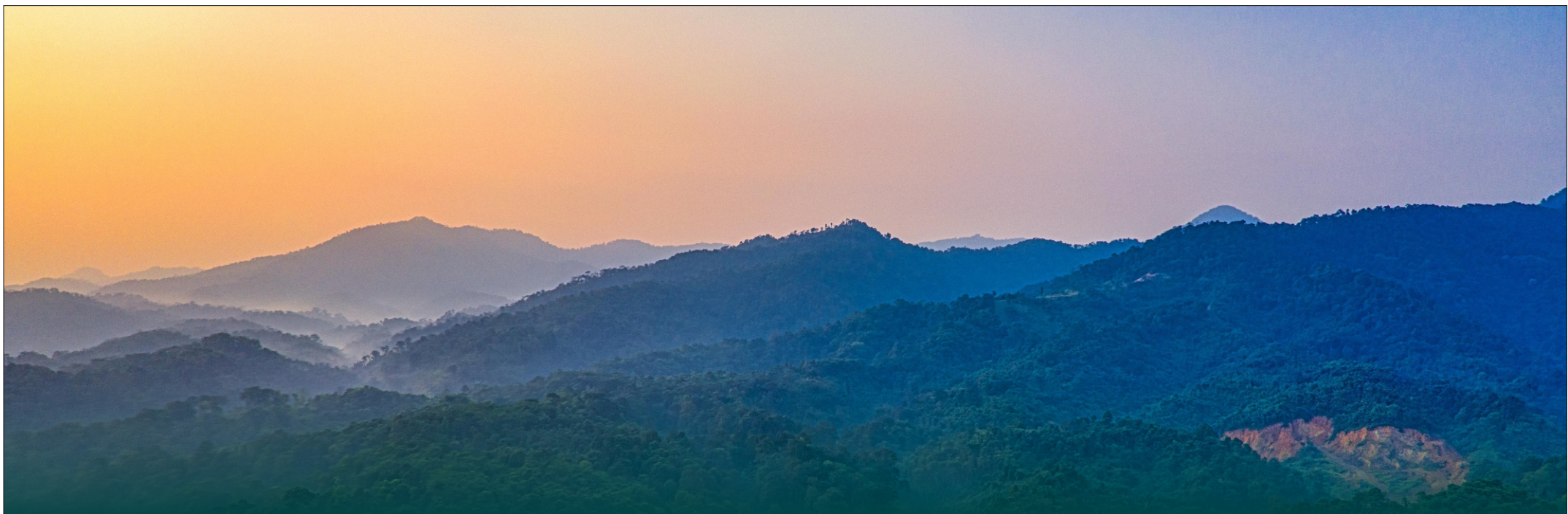
